Subject: Review of Non Householder Permitted Development rights

Sirs,

Having lived near to the Old Bishopscourt Airfield, and suffered under the noise and disturbance caused by the Motor vehicle racing over the last 16 years, I believe that the planning should be strengthen against use land for whatever purpose.

You are no doubt aware of the case at Bishopscourt which ended up with a public enquiry.at considerable expense to all those concerned.

I attach a document which was submitted by local residents at the time of the enquiry.

Racing has continued at the Airfield under the terms of the planning granted.

But in addition to this racing takes place on an adjacent part of the Airfield regardless to any planning restrictions.

This often takes place on a Saturday and Sunday when it is impossible to report it to the relevant authorities.

I therefore strongly advocate that the planning laws regarding the Non House Holder Development Rights should be made more stringent to prevent such occurrences as at the Bishopscourt Airfield.
