

## **DRAFT PLAN REVISION (27 March 2007) STATEMENT**

### **Draft Banbridge / Newry and Mourne Area Plan 2015**

#### **Department of the Environment**

#### **The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991**

The Banbridge / Newry and Mourne Area Plan 2015 Draft Plan was prepared under Part 111 of the Planning (NI) Order 1991 and was published in August 2006. Anyone who wished to object to any of the policies or proposals contained in the Draft Plan was invited to do so in writing before 17 October 2006.

Following the publication of the Draft Plan a number of mapping errors have become apparent with regard to Map No. 3/01c Newry & Mourne District - East. These errors relate to the definition of boundaries of the following designations in the Draft Plan:

- Designation NC 06 .....Mourne Countryside Policy Area
- Designation NC 09 .....Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area
- Designation NC 11 .....Coastal Policy Area

These errors have now been rectified and the Department is now revising Map No. 3/01c Newry & Mourne District - East to show the correct boundaries. The revised map is entitled:

Draft Plan Revision Statement (27 March 2007)**

**1.0 Designation NC06 – Mourne Countryside Policy Area**

General nature of changes – The Mourne Countryside Policy Area has been reduced in a number of specific locations, as detailed below. The Eastern Mournes Special Area of Conservation (SAC) and the Carlingford Lough Special Protected Area (SPA) are now both shown as being wholly outside the Mourne Countryside Policy Area designation.

- 1.1 North East of 286 Moyad Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.2 North of 84 Head Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.3 North West of 97 Head Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.4 North East of 100 Head Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.5 West of 140 Head Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.6 South East of junction of Head Road and Ballyveaghbeg Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.7 North of junction of Head Road and Oldtown Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.8 North West of 14 Old Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Mournes Special Countryside Policy Area).
- 1.9 South East of 201 Killowen Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Coastal Policy Area).
- 1.10 West of White Water Bridge, Benagh Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Coastal Policy Area).
- 1.11 North West of 33 Greencastle Pier Road (Mourne Countryside Policy Area reduced – area affected changes to Coastal Policy Area).

## **2.0 Designation NC09 – Mourne Special Countryside Policy Area**

General nature of changes – The Mourne Special Countryside Policy Area has been increased in a number of specific locations, as detailed in **Paragraphs 1.1 to 1.8 overleaf**. The Eastern Mourne Special Area of Conservation (SAC) is now shown as being wholly inside the Mourne Special Countryside Policy Area designation.

## **3.0 Designation NC11 – Coastal Policy Area**

General nature of changes – The Coastal Policy Area has been increased in a number of specific locations, as detailed in **Paragraphs 1.9 to 1.11 overleaf**. The Carlingford Lough Special Protected Area (SPA) is now shown as being wholly inside the Coastal Policy Area designation.
