

# Consultation On Review Of Planning Agreement With Belfast City Airport



The Department of the Environment has launched a public consultation exercise seeking views on proposals to review the current Belfast City Airport (BCA) Planning Agreement.

The Planning Agreement, which controls certain aspects of BCA's operations, covers a number of key operational issues including the number of seats for sale, operating hours, air transport movements, noise and flight paths. BCA has sought an increase in the number of passenger movements, through a review of the seats for sale restriction, and the Department seeks views on this proposal in the context of the overall Planning Agreement.
