



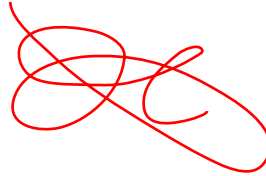

With reference to the article in Community Telegraph dated 26th November 2004, I would like to express my views regarding Belfast City Airport.

I think a balance has to be made between quality of life and safety for residents living under the flight paths. There have been a significant number of flights coming and going after the 9.30pm curfew. The noise has also increased significantly and sometimes it is impossible to hear TV programmes being viewed in our homes.

I would like to see key operational issues being addressed i.e., number of seats for sale, operating hours, air transport movements, noise and flight paths restricted. There needs to be a balance between the needs of the travelling public and the rights of local residents.
