Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing with regard to Belfast City Airports request to increase the throughput of passengers. This will inevitably lead to increased air traffic over the city of belfast. I am writing to object to this request on the grounds of noise pollution and significant disruption to telecommunications.

I live in the Ballynafeigh area of Belfast City and this is directly beneath the flight path of some incoming aircraft. I currently experience unacceptably high levels of noise pollution when approaching aircraft fly directly over my house.

I also experience unacceptably high levels of telecommunication disruption to my television transmission when planes fly directly overhead. The government has deemed that it is everyones right to receive good television transmission especially when a licence fee has been paid for these. I believe an increased number of flights would increase the disruption to my television transmission and subsequently impinge upon my rights as a licence payer. Unless Belfast City Airport can review the disruption caused to householders immediately under the flight path then I must strongly object to this application.
