**The Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 2015 (Regulation 23)**

Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council Area

Location: Land approximately 920 metres north west of 33 Craigmores Road, Coleraine, Co. Londonderry BT51 4EX

Proposal: A wind farm comprising 6 turbines up to a maximum tip height of 120.5m (comprising a configuration of up to 85m towers and up to 35.5m blades). The development will also comprise associated transformers, one permanent meteorological monitoring mast, communication tower, site access tracks, gates, temporary site compound, substation, electrical cabling, one site entrance including road improvement works at the existing site entrance off Craigmores Road, and all other ancillary works.

The Department of the Environment (now the Department for Infrastructure) issued a notice of opinion to approve this planning application. Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council asked for the application to be referred to the Planning Appeals Commission for a hearing under Section 29(7) of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011.

The hearing will open at 10.00am Tuesday 30 August 2016 in the Lodge Hotel, Lodge Road Roundabout, Coleraine and continue as necessary on the following day.
