Sand and gravel to be extracted from within two distinct areas totalling some 3.1km², in the north-west of Lough Neagh situated approximately east of Traad Point, north of Stanierds Point, west of Doss Point and south of Ballyronan and the ancillary deposition of silt and fine material.

Location: Lough Neagh, within the Mid Ulster District Council, Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council, Armagh Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council and Lisburn and Castlereagh Council Areas
