

Planning Application Likely To Have Significant Environmental Effects On Northern Ireland

Planning Application Accompanied by an Environmental Statement Regulation 28 of The Planning (EIA) Regulations (NI) 2015

The Department has received notification from An Bord Pleanála that it has received a planning appeal in relation to Donegal County Council's decision to refuse planning permission for the following proposal. The appeal is also accompanied by Further Environmental Information for the following development which is likely to have significant effects on the environment in Northern Ireland.

Proposal: Permission for a grant of a ten year planning permission to construct a five turbine windfarm, the development will comprise of up to 5 no electricity generating wind turbines with an overall height of the turbines not exceeding 150 metres. The development will also comprise of hardstandings, an electrical compound, and sub-station building with grid system services equipment, associated site roads and site works.
