Proposal: **Wind farm of 5 no. wind turbines with an overall base to blade tip height of 120.5 metres. Ancillary developments will comprise turbine transformers; turbine hardstands; construction of new access tracks and junctions; an electrical control building; communications antennae; underground electrical cables and communications lines connecting wind turbines to the electrical control building; on site drainage works and all ancillary and associated works.**
