Location: Hightown Quarry, 40a Boghill Road, Ballyutoag, Co Antrim and lands adjacent to the existing Boghill Road from its junction with Hydepark Road to the west of the existing access road into Hightown Quarry.

Proposal: Proposed development of a Residual Waste Treatment Facility incorporating a Mechanical and Biological Treatment (MBT) facility, an Energy from Waste (EfW) Thermal Treatment facility, an Incinerator Bottom Ash (IBA) Treatment facility, a Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) Bale Storage building, an Administration/Visitor Centre and related infrastructure including widening of the Boghill Road from its junction with Hydepark Road to west of the existing access road into Hightown Quarry site and other ancillary works (voluntary further environmental information received, supporting documents and amended drawings).
