Mid and east Antrim Council has examined the following planning application which was accompanied by an Environmental Statement, has assessed its impact on the environment as required by the Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015 and has granted planning permission for the proposed development.

**Application No:** F/2013/0244/F

**Location:** Ballykeel and Old Freehold townlands, Larne, Co Antrim.

Haul route: Rory's Glen, Old Freehold Townlands

**Proposal:** Proposed Wind farm comprising of 7 no. wind turbines each with a maximum base to blade tip height of 99.5 metres. Proposed ancillary developments include internal turbine transformers, turbine bases, foundations and hardstands; widening and strengthening of existing deposition area; communications antennae; and electrical control building and compound with LiDAR equipment for wind measurement; a temporary contractors compound; underground electrical cables and communications lines connecting wind turbines to the electrical control building; on-site drainage works; and all ancillary, associated and general excavation works. The proposed development also includes road widening and improvement works within the public verge on sections of the transport route along Shane's Hill Road and Starbog Road
